AT THE ISLE OF WIGHT COLLEGE

Who is this course for?

This Foundation Level course is for new college learners, usually aged 16-18 (older learners are considered) who need flexibility, or additional support or a period to adjust to a new learning environment, or who want to build confidence, gain experience, make choices and develop new skills.

What do I need to join this course?

There is an interview but no formal entry qualifications are required.

How Will I Decide What to Choose?

You will be encouraged to look at the local employment opportunities and think about your own strengths and ability to learn new skills in these areas. You will try out a number of different practical things that may be suitable for you and gain work experience such as catering, construction, horticulture, land, hair and beauty etc. by individual arrangement.

After qualifications, work experience is the most important thing employers look for in a CV. This course will give you the work experience needed for a good CV.

How Will I Learn?

You will learn in a friendly and supportive environment to develop your confidence, to become more independent and to improve your practical skills and team work. There will also be some English, maths and ICT in short sessions. All learners who require additional learning support will receive this with the aim of working towards independent learning.

What Can This Course Lead To?

This course can lead to further work-related learning at Entry 3 or Level 1. Learners could move into entry level employment but are encouraged to use their entitlement to study further at this stage. Learners will be supported to work out their next steps whilst they are on this course.

When Can I Start?

Start dates are flexible so there are start points throughout the year
