

## Communication Pathway Programme Courses for people with Learning difficulties and or disabilities

This programme is open to those people who would benefit from a sensory approach to learning and is suitable for those learners with more complex needs. Staff are trained in Intensive Interaction and Sherborne Development. Personal care facilities are available and the college has its own sensory room.

This course aims to develop skills in the following areas:

- communication
- physical and motor skills
- sensory and cognitive skills
- emotional and social

Activities offered may include:

- Individual sensory room programmes
- Sherborne Developmental Movement
- Art
- Music
- Intensive Interaction
- Community Awareness
- Assistive Technology



There are tuition and material fees for this course; however tuition fees may be waived if you are 16 – 18, over 19yrs and under 25yrs and have an S139 or EHCP in place. You may be entitled to a bursary from the college to help pay for fees depending on personal circumstances. Classes are small and well supported. Students can progress on to other supported learning or community engagement opportunities. Full or part time classes available.
